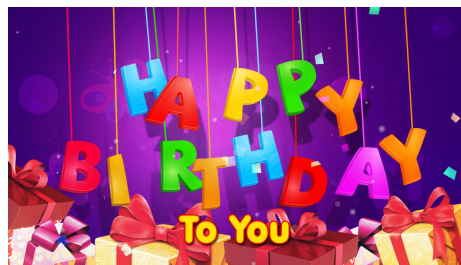
## Message from the South
