

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT APPLYING FOR MEMBERSHIP (Applicant may keep this page for reference)

Freemasonry has always insisted that men come to its doors entirely of their own free will, without being solicited for membership. You should submit your application only if you completely understand and agree with all the information in this application.

There is nothing mysterious or exotic about our organization. It is an ancient fraternity which began in Europe during the Middle Ages. It promotes ideals that are entirely consistent with what we believe are a man's civil, moral and religious duties. Although we have confidential signs and passwords by which we are able to recognize each other, we are not a secret society.

Masonry does not support any particular religion or political position. It is based on the great principles of belief in the Supreme Being (a person's God) and the brotherhood of Man. We believe that we owe to God, our neighbors, and ourselves a duty to practice virtue in our daily lives. We use the "working tools" of a stonemason and other symbols to demonstrate these principles.

Freemasonry "makes good men better". You must not be motivated to join for unworthy purposes. You should not enter our ranks hoping or expecting that you will derive any financial or material benefit. You should not join merely because you are curious. You should have a favorable opinion of the Institution, a desire for knowledge, and a charitable disposition. The aim of our Order is to cultivate brotherly friendship, and a willingness to assist our members, their families and the community around us. We also promote truth, honesty, fair dealing, and equality among all men. Finally, good citizenship is an essential quality of Masonic character, and we accept only those who cheerfully obey every lawful authority. You cannot be admitted if you have been convicted of a felony or a crime involving moral turpitude.

Your admission to our Craft will entail certain financial obligations which you must be able to discharge without detriment to yourself or your family. Furthermore, you are presumed to be self-sufficient and cannot expect financial support from the Lodge. From to time to time you may also be asked if you are willing to make a purely *voluntary* contribution for Masonic charity work. The application fee to join the Lodge is \$200.00, which is refundable if your application is not approved, plus a non-refundable fee of \$25 for a background check (total = **\$225.00**). Our current annual dues are \$65.00, plus an annual "per capita tax" assessed by the Grand Lodge of Hawaii (\$38 in 2022, \$40 in 2023).

If your application is approved by the Lodge, you will be *initiated* an Entered Apprentice Mason. After demonstrating your "proficiency" as an "EA", you will be *passed* to the Degree of Fellowcraft, and after demonstrating your proficiency in that Degree, you will be *raised* to the "sublime" Degree of Master Mason, thereby becoming a full-fledged member of the Lodge. If you are unable to present yourself for all three Degrees within three years after initiation, your fees may be forfeited.
