Cocktail hour at 6pm Dinner at 7pm

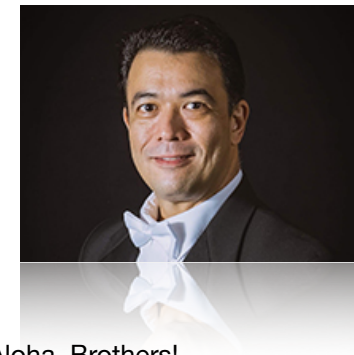
